



UFV CASCADES HIGH SCHOOL THREE-POINT CONTEST

Contest rules

1. Participants will have one minute to make as many three-point shots as possible from five positions behind the three-point arc in less than a minute. At each station is a rack with five basketballs.
2. Players begin shooting at one corner of the court and move from station to station along the arc until they reach the other corner.
3. Out of the five balls at each station, four are worth one point, and the fifth (the “money ball”) is worth two.
4. The top three scores from the preliminary round on both the boys and girls sides will advance to the finals at halftime of the evening Cascades games. The three female finalists will shoot at halftime of the UFV women’s game, and the three male finalists will shoot at halftime of the UFV men’s game.
5. Any ties – either at the end of the preliminary round or the finals – will be broken by a sudden-death shootout from the centre position beyond the three-point arc. Order will be decided via rock-paper-scissors, with the winner getting to choose whether they’d prefer to shoot first or second. If the first player hits their shot, the second player must also hit to extend the shootout; if one or the other misses, the player who makes it will be declared the winner.
